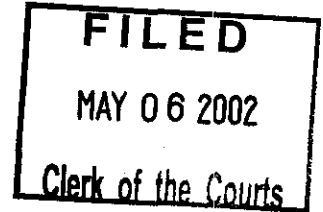

ORDER

This case is before the Court upon the Board of Professional Responsibility's Petition for Reciprocal Discipline pursuant to Section 17, Rule 9 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court.

On March 15, 2002, the Supreme Court entered a Notice for the Respondent to show cause, if any, why the reciprocal discipline of disbarment should not be imposed in Tennessee. The Respondent failed to respond to this Notice.

Therefore, after consideration of the entire file, the Court is of the opinion that the Petition is well taken and the reciprocal discipline as requested by the Board of Professional Responsibility is approved.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** by the Court that the Respondent, Christopher David Adams, is **disbarred**.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Respondent shall comply with Section 18 of Rule 9, Rules of the Supreme Court.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Respondent shall be taxed with costs in the amount of \$209.00, for which execution may issue if necessary.
