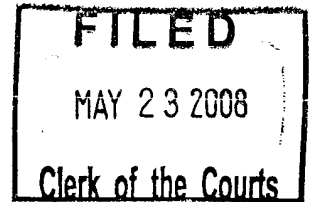

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT


The Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court ("the Board"), by and through Disciplinary Counsel, filed a Petition for Discipline against Respondent, James D. Adams, on July 6, 2006.

Pursuant to Rule 9, § 16.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent submitted a Conditional Guilty Plea on May 17, 2007 in exchange for the stated form of discipline of a public censure. The Conditional Guilty Plea has been approved by a Hearing Panel and the Board.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that:

1. Respondent is publicly censured for his violation of Rules of Professional Conduct 1.4(a)(b), 1.7(c) and 8.4(a)(c) and (d).
2. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the sum of \$1,519.00, and in addition shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
3. The Board shall cause notice of this public censure to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
