## ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition of Disciplinary Counsel for the temporary suspension of Nathanael E. Anderson from the practice of law pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chairman of the Board of Professional Responsibility. The Petition is supported by the Affidavits of Judge E. Shayne Sexton, Chancellor Daryl R. Fansler, Judge April Meldrum, attorney Judith Fain, attorney Rachel Nelley, attorney Marjorie A. Bristol, Assistant District Attorney Emily Abbott, Assistant District Attorney Mendi Winstead, Assistant District Attorney Alexandra Deas, attorney Rolfe Straussfogel, Associate Director of the Tennessee Commission on Continuing Legal Education Andrea Curl, and Deputy Chief Disciplinary Counsel-Litigation Sandy Garrett. Based upon the Petition and supporting Affidavits, the Court finds that Nathanael E. Anderson has continued to practice law after being suspended, has misrepresented that he has been reinstated when he remains suspended and therefore poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

## IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that:

- 1. Nathanael E. Anderson is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court.
- 2. Nathanael E. Anderson shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- 3. Nathanael E. Anderson, Respondent, may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Rule 9.

The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9.
