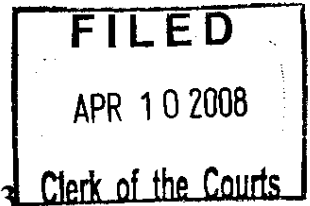

ORDER


This matter is before the Court pursuant to Section 14 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9 upon a certificate filed by Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility consisting of a certified copy of a Plea Agreement entered in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Mississippi, No. 3:07CR192 (attached hereto as Exhibit A), demonstrating that on December 4, 2007, Timothy R. Balducci, a Tennessee attorney, plead guilty to a charge involving a serious crime, to wit: conspiracy to commit bribery of an elected state official, 18 U.S.C. Section 371.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED**, pursuant to Section 14 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, that Timothy R. Balducci is suspended from the practice of law on this date pending further orders of this Court.

It is further **ORDERED** that this matter be referred to the Board of Professional Responsibility for the institution of a formal proceeding in which the sole issue to be determined shall be the extent of the final discipline to be imposed as a result of the conviction.

It is further **ORDERED** that Timothy R. Balducci shall fully comply with the provisions of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys.
