Respondent neglected his client's legal matter and failed to adequately communicate with his client. The client's case was dismissed by Order entered May 5, 2003 for failure to prosecute. Respondent failed to advise his client of this dismissal.

By these acts and omissions Respondent violated Rules 1.3; 1.4; and 8.4(d) of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct. Respondent is hereby censured for these violations.
