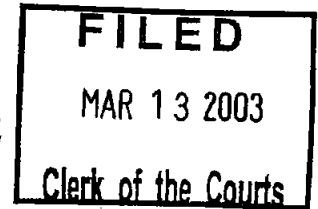

ORDER

On January 31, 2003, the Court entered an Order of Temporary Suspension suspending Howard Brownlow Barnwell pursuant to Section 4.3 Supreme Court Rule 9, for failure to file a response to a complaint of misconduct. On February 12, 2003, Mr. Barnwell filed a Petition for Dissolution of Order of Temporary Suspension pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.


On February 24, 2003, a hearing was conducted before a three-member Hearing Panel composed of two members of the Board of Professional Responsibility and one Hearing Committee Member in Disciplinary District III. On March 6, 2003, the Hearing Panel filed its Recommendation of the 4.3 Hearing Panel, recommending that the temporary suspension imposed by the Order of Temporary Suspension filed January 31, 2003, be dissolved upon Mr. Barnwell's complying with Section 18 of Supreme Court Rule 9 and filing the affidavit required by Section 18.8 of Supreme Court Rule 9. Mr. Barnwell filed the required affidavit with the Board of Professional Responsibility on February 28, 2003. A copy of the Recommendations of the 4.3 Hearing Panel is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that the temporary suspension imposed upon Howard Brownlow Barnwell by Order of Temporary Suspension filed January 31, 2003, is hereby dissolved and Howard Brownlow Barnwell is reinstated to the practice of law.




