ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Howard Brownlow Barnwell from the practice of law, pursuant to section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of James A. Vick, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting affidavit, the Court finds that Howard Brownlow Barnwell, Respondent, has failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a complaint of misconduct.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court:

1. That Howard Brownlow Barnwell is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9, of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.

- 2. That Howard Brownlow Barnwell shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- 3. That Howard Brownlow Barnwell may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 4. That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
