ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on April 17, 2024, by Petitioner Matthew David Barocas. Mr. Barocas was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on January 18, 2024, for a period of one (1) year, with three (3) months to be served as an active suspension and the remainder to be served on probation. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating that the Petition for Reinstatement is satisfactory to the Board, that Mr. Barocas has satisfied the conditions set forth in the Order of Enforcement imposing discipline, and that he is eligible for reinstatement and probation.

From all of which, the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, Matthew David Barocas, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the state of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), and the remainder of his one (1) year suspension shall be served on probation.
2. Mr. Barocas's reinstatement to the active practice of law and grant of probation is conditioned upon his continuing compliance with and timely satisfaction of the conditions set forth in the Order of Enforcement entered January 18, 2024. In the event Mr. Barocas fails to satisfy any condition of probation as set forth in the Order of Enforcement, the probation may be revoked pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 14.2.
3. Mr. Barocas shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution may be issued if necessary.

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
