**ORDER OF TRANSFER TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS**

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition for Transfer to Disability Inactive Status of Wilbert Allen Barrett filed by Disciplinary Counsel pursuant to Rule 9, Section 21.2 of the Rules of the Supreme Court. The Board of Professional Responsibility asserts that Wilbert Allen Barrett is incapacitated and cannot practice law. Evidence of Wilbert Allen Barrett's condition has been provided as Exhibit A to the Petition.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court:

1. That pursuant to Rule 9, Section 21.2 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Wilbert Allen Barrett's license to practice law is hereby transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period and until further Order of this Court.
2. That pursuant to Rule 9, Section 25.2 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, this Order shall become a public record upon filing; however, all other documents relating to this disability proceeding shall not become public records and shall be kept confidential.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this transfer to disability inactive status to be published as required by Rule 9, Section 21.4 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
