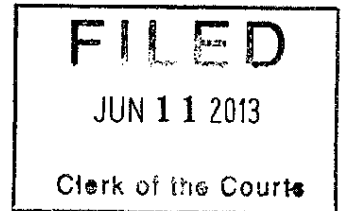

**ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO
DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS**

This matter is before the Court upon a petition to transfer Samuel Wilson Bartholomew, Jr., to disability inactive status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 § 21.2 filed by the Tennessee Board of Professional Responsibility.

Upon due consideration of medical documentation submitted by Sterling I. Barrett, M. D., the Court concludes that Samuel Wilson Bartholomew, Jr., is currently incapacitated from continuing the practice of law.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that:

1. The law license of Samuel Wilson Bartholomew, Jr., shall be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time and until further orders of the Supreme Court.
2. Mr. Bartholomew shall be allowed to petition for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 § 21.6.
3. The Board shall publish notice of this transfer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 §§ 21.4 and 21.5.
4. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 § 25.2, documents other than this Order relating to Mr. Bartholomew's disability proceeding shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
