DAVIDSON COUNTY LAWYER REINSTATED

On July 2, 2014, the Supreme Court of Tennessee reinstated Edward T. Kindall to the practice of law. Mr. Kindall had been suspended by the Supreme Court of Tennessee on December 26, 2013, for a period of one (1) year retroactive to May 13, 2013. On May 14, 2014, Mr. Kindall filed a Petition for Reinstatement to the practice of law pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, § 30.4(c) (2014). The Board found that the Petition was satisfactory and submitted an Order of Reinstatement to the Court.

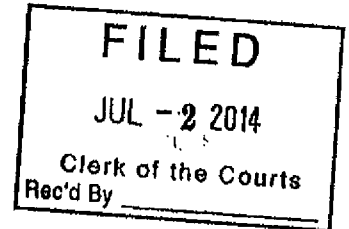

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on May 14, 2014, by the Petitioner, Edward Kindall. Mr. Kindall was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on May 13, 2014, for a period of one (1) year, retroactive to May 13, 2013. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating that the petition is satisfactory to the Board and that Mr. Kindall has satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline and that he is eligible for reinstatement.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court:

1. The Petitioner, Edward Kindall, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §30.4(c).
2. Mr. Kindall shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
