ORDER ON RULE 59.04 MOTION TO ALTER OR AMEND


This matter came before the Panel upon the Board of Professional Responsibility's Motion to Alter or Amend the Order of the Hearing Panel filed pursuant to Tenn. R. Civ. P. 59.04. In the motion, the Board moved the Panel to alter or amend the Order of the Hearing Panel entered on October 6, 2017, to comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.2(a) and impose an active suspension of not less than thirty (30) days.

The Panel has considered the Board's Motion to Alter or Amend and unanimously finds good cause for granting such motion. Accordingly, it is the unanimous conclusion of the Panel that the Panel's previous order of October 6, 2017, shall be altered or amended to reflect that Respondent Bowman shall be suspended from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.2 for a period of one (1) year to be served with thirty (30) days of active suspension from the practice of law and the remaining time to be served on probation pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 14.1. The other conditions of probation as explained in the Panel's Order of October 6, 2017, shall remain the same. Therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Panel's October 6, 2017 Order is altered and amended as stated above and Respondent shall be suspended from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.2 for a period of one (1) year to be served with thirty (30) days of active suspension from the practice of law and the remaining time to be served on probation pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 14.1 and the other conditions of probation as outlined in the Panel's October 6, 2017 Order.


