SHELBY COUNTY LAWYER REINSTATED

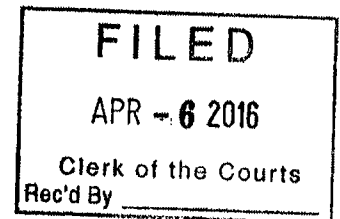
On April 6, 2016, the Supreme Court of Tennessee reinstated Andrewnetta Melissa Boyd to the practice of law. Ms. Boyd had been suspended by the Supreme Court of Tennessee on December 21, 2015, for a period of thirty (30) days. Ms. Boyd filed a Petition for Reinstatement to the practice of law pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 30.4(c) (2014). The Board found that the Petition was satisfactory and submitted an Order of Reinstatement to the Court.

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on March 1, 2016, by the Petitioner, Andrewnetta Melissa Boyd. Ms. Boyd was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on December 21, 2015, for a period of thirty (30) days. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating that the petition is satisfactory to the Board and that Ms. Boyd has satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline and that she is eligible for reinstatement.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, Andrewnetta Melissa Boyd, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §30.4(c).
2. Ms. Boyd shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
