- 3. Bennett Farris Bratcher may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Bennett Farris Bratcher to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
