## ORDER

On August 6, 2008, the Court entered an Order of Temporary Suspension suspending Tony N. Brayton pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9 for failure to respond to a complaint of misconduct. On August 19, 2008, Mr. Brayton filed a Petition For Dissolution of the Temporary Suspension pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.

On August 27, 2008, a hearing was conducted before a three-member Hearing Panel composed of two members of the Board of Professional Responsibility and a Hearing Committee Member. On September 4, 2008, the Hearing Panel entered its Recommendation, recommending that the temporary suspension imposed by the Order of Temporary Suspension be dissolved. A copy of the Recommendation of the 4.3 Hearing Panel is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

## It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

- 1. The temporary suspension imposed upon Tony N. Brayton by Order of Temporary Suspension filed August 6, 2008, is hereby dissolved and Tony N. Brayton is reinstated to the practice of law;
- 2. Mr. Brayton shall reimburse and pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the costs and expenses of this proceeding in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Six Dollars and Forty Nine Cents (\$156.49), and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
