#### ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

The Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, filed a Petition for Discipline on December 28, 2005 against the Respondent, Stuart B. Breakstone, a Shelby County, Tennessee lawyer.

Pursuant to Section 16.1 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Respondent submitted a Conditional Guilty Plea in exchange for a stated form of discipline. The Guilty Plea embraces complaint number 27969-9-LC. A copy of the Conditional Guilty Plea is attached as Exhibit A.

Respondent admitted his guilt of violating Rules 1.7(b) and 8.4(a)(d) of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.

It is therefore **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that the Respondent, Stuart B. Breakstone, be and hereby is **publicly censured** for being removed as counsel for an ex-wife/mother as a result of a conflict of interest arising from his personal relationship with that client during that representation in a post-divorce/custody proceeding.

It is further **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that Respondent, Stuart B. Breakstone, shall pay the costs in this matter of \$1,149.07, and in addition, shall pay the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.

The Board of Professional Responsibility is directed to make notification of this public censure as provided in Section 18.10 of Supreme Court Rule 9.


