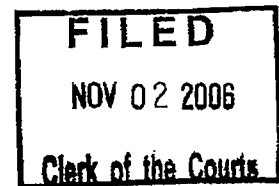

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon the petition of Disciplinary Counsel for the temporary suspension of Thomas Martin Browder from the practice of law pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The petition has been authorized by the Board of Professional Responsibility. This petition is supported by the affidavit of Disciplinary Counsel that he has received notice that Respondent Browder is in substantial noncompliance with his Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program Monitoring Agreement.


It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** by the Court:

1. That Respondent, Thomas Martin Browder is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court.
2. That Respondent, Thomas Martin Browder shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects and, particularly, as provided in Section 18.
3. That Respondent, Thomas Martin Browder may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Rule 9.


