#### **ORDER**

On December 14, 2010, the Court entered an Order of Temporary Suspension suspending Christopher Lee Brown pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9 due to Mr. Brown's failure to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a request for specific information regarding complaints of misconduct, File Nos. 32906-KB and 33232c-9-KB. On December 17, 2010, Mr. Brown filed a Petition for Dissolution of Temporary Suspension pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.

On December 29, 2010, a hearing was conducted before a three-member Hearing Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility. On December 29, 2010, the Hearing Panel entered its Order Recommending Dissolution of Temporary Suspension, recommending that the temporary suspension imposed by the Order of Temporary Suspension be dissolved. A copy of the Order Recommending Dissolution of Temporary Suspension of the 4.3 Hearing Panel is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

#### It is, therefore, **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that:

- 1. The temporary suspension imposed upon Christopher Lee Brown by Order of Temporary Suspension filed December 14, 2010, is hereby dissolved and Christopher Lee Brown is reinstated to the practice of law;
- 2. Mr. Brown shall reimburse and pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the costs and expenses of this proceeding in the amount of \$390.00, and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
