ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by Disciplinary Counsel as to Respondent, Patricia Spicer Carden. Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel have signed a Settlement Agreement relative to this matter. Both a Hearing Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility and the Board of Professional Responsibility have approved the agreement and have recommended its adoption by this Court. This Court hereby approves and adopts this Settlement Agreement.

It is hereby **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court, that the Respondent is **disbarred**.

It is further **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court, that Respondent, Patricia Spicer Carden, pursuant to Section 24.3 of Rule 9 of this Court, shall reimburse and pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of four hundred and thirty-nine dollars and no cents (\$439.00.) In addition, Respondent, Patricia Spicer Carden, shall pay the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred therein, for all of which execution shall issue if necessary.

The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this disbarment to be published pursuant to Section 18 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9.
