Respondent neglected his client's legal matter and failed to adequately communicate with his client. By these acts and omissions Respondent violated rules 1.1; 1.3; 1.4

and 8.4 of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.

FILE NO. 27060c-8-sg

Respondent neglected his client's legal matter and failed to adequately communicate with his client. By these acts and omissions Respondent violated rules 1.3; 1.4 and 8.4(d) of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.

Respondent is hereby censured for these violations.
