PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against John David Carver, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter at its meeting on June 12, 2026.

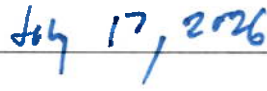
Mr. Carver's law license was administratively suspended due to his failure to comply with the requirements of the Tennessee Commission on Continuing Legal Education. Mr. Carver was aware of his failure to comply with the requirements, and he had received multiple notices from the Commission. Mr. Carver practiced law for two months, including participation in nine court hearings in three counties, while his license was suspended.

By these acts, John David Carver has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law), 3.4 (fairness to opposing party and counsel), and 8.4(d) and (g) (misconduct) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
