ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 22.3, upon a Notice of Submission filed by Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility consisting of a copy of the Verdict Form in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Tennessee, in the matter of *State of Tennessee v. Edythe Christie*, demonstrating that Edythe Paschall Christie, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, has been found guilty of the offense of Tampering with Evidence.

- 3. Edythe Paschall Christie shall fully comply with the provisions of Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys; and
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
