On September 27, 2012, Mr. Craig received a Public Reprimand by the Mississippi Bar for practicing law in that jurisdiction without a license. The evidence demonstrated that Mr. Craig assisted in drafting complaint and a response to a motion to dismiss and gave legal advice to the client in the matter.

By the aforementioned acts, Paul Forrest Craig has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) and 8.5 (disciplinary authority) and is hereby Publicly Consured for these violations.
