AGREED ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel for the temporary suspension of Scott Eric Crawford from the practice of law pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chairman of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of FBI Special Agent Eric S. McCraw filed in the US District Court for the Western District of Tennessee in *USA v. Scott Crawford*, Case No. 2:04cr20103-01-D, the consent of respondent to this suspension, and the March 5, 2004 Amended Order of the US District Court for the Western District of Tennessee granting respondent supervised release which also prohibits respondent from engaging in the practice of law as a condition of his supervised release.

Based upon the Petition, the supporting affidavit, agreement of respondent to imposition of immediate temporary suspension until the conclusion of the prosecution against him in US District Court, the Order of the US District Court granting respondent supervised release, and the record as a whole, the Court finds that the continued practice of law by respondent Scott Eric Crawford poses a risk of irreparable harm to the general public.


It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court:

1. That Scott Eric Crawford is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. R. Sup. Ct. 9, §4.3, and as agreed to before the US District Court.
2. That Scott Eric Crawford is hereby precluded from practicing law in any form, but shall be entitled to petition this court for dissolution or modification of this Order upon his acquittal of the federal charges or upon dismissal of same by the US District Court.
3. That Scott Eric Crawford shall comply with Tenn. R. Sup. Ct. 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. R. Sup. Ct. 9.


