DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS OF WEAKLEY COUNTY LAWYER REMOVED;
TEMPORARY SUSPENSION REMAINS IN EFFECT

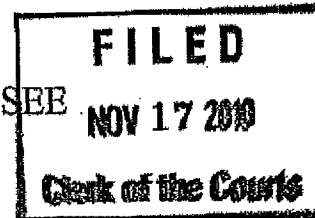
On November 25, 2009, the Supreme Court entered an Order transferring Mr. Crowe to disability inactive status and staying his temporary suspension. On November 17, 2010, the Tennessee Supreme Court issued an Order removing the disability inactive status of Kyle Eric Crowe.

Although the disability inactive status has been removed, Mr. Crowe remains temporarily suspended for misappropriation of funds. This suspension remains in effect until dissolution or modification by the Tennessee Supreme Court.

**ORDER DISSOLVING DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS
AND REINSTATING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION**

This matter is before the Court, upon the Petition for Reinstatement to Active Status of the Respondent, Kyle Eric Crowe. On November 25, 2009, the Court entered an Order transferring Respondent to disability inactive status and staying Respondent's temporarily suspension.

In accordance with Rule 9, §21.6, upon due consideration of medical documentation submitted by Respondent, the Court concludes that the Respondent has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Respondent's disability has been removed.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** by the Court:

1. That Kyle Eric Crowe's disability inactive status be removed and that the November 24, 2009 Order temporarily suspending his law license is reinstated.
2. That Kyle Eric Crowe shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly in Section 18.
3. That Kyle Eric Crowe may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.

4. That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Kyle Eric Crowe to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
