R. 9, §24.3, Mr. Daly shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$500.00, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
- 3. The Board shall cause notice of this Public Censure to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §18.10.
