ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Mickie Smith Daugherty from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of Michael C. Brett, Disciplinary Counsel, and the Affidavit of Sarah Pearce, Esq.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavits, the Court finds Mickie Smith Daugherty, Respondent, misappropriated funds and property for her personal use, poses a threat of substantial harm to the public, and failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a complaint of misconduct.

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

- 1. Mickie Smith Daugherty is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 2. Mickie Smith Daugherty shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
- 3. Mickie Smith Daugherty may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Mickie Smith Daugherty to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
