KNOXVILLE LAWYER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

On February 2, 2009, the Supreme Court of Tennessee issued an Order summarily and temporarily suspending Aubrey Lewis Davis from the practice of law upon finding that Mr. Davis has failed to substantially comply with his Monitoring Agreement with the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program ("TLAP"). Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9 provides for the immediate summary suspension of an attorney's license to practice law in cases of substantial noncompliance with a contract entered into with TLAP.

Effective February 2, 2009, Mr. Davis is precluded from accepting any new cases and he must cease representing existing clients by March 4, 2009. After March 4, 2009, Mr. Davis shall not use any indicia of lawyer, legal assistant, or law clerk nor maintain a presence where the practice of law is conducted.

Mr. Davis must notify all clients being represented in pending matters, as well as co-counsel and opposing counsel of the Supreme Court's Order suspending his law license. Section 18 of Supreme Court Rule 9 requires Mr. Davis to deliver to all clients any papers or property to which they are entitled.

This suspension remains in effect until dissolution or modification by the Supreme Court. Mr. Davis may for good cause request dissolution or modification of the suspension by petition to the Supreme Court.
