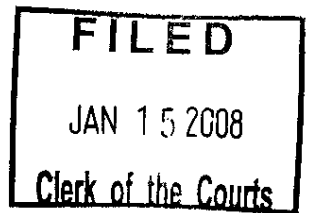

ORDER


This matter is before the Court upon a Petition to Dissolve and/or Modify the Order of Temporary Suspension filed by Respondent, Aubrey Lewis Davis, on October 11, 2007; upon the recommendations of a Hearing Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") filed on November 26, 2007; and upon a motion filed by the Board requesting that certain documents be filed under seal.

From all of which the Court grants Respondent's petition, adopts the recommendations of the Hearing Panel, and finds that the documents specified by the Board should be filed under seal.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the COURT:

- (1) That Respondent's temporary suspension is hereby dissolved and Respondent is permitted to resume the practice of law pending the resolution of the disciplinary complaints filed against him;
- (2) That pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay the costs of these proceedings as a condition precedent to his resumption of the practice of law; and
- (3) That the documents specified in the Board's motion shall be filed under seal.
