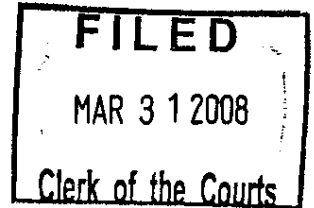

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION


This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Aubrey Lewis Davis from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of Krisann Hodges, Disciplinary Counsel.

On November 15, 2007, Aubrey Lewis Davis entered into a Monitoring Agreement with the Tennessee Lawyer's Assistance Program (TLAP), which permits TLAP to make monitoring reports to the Board of Professional Responsibility with regard to compliance with the contract. Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Aubrey Lewis Davis is in substantial non-compliance with his Monitoring Agreement with the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Aubrey Lewis Davis is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9, of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
2. Aubrey Lewis Davis shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
3. Aubrey Lewis Davis may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Aubrey Lewis Davis to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
