

## **ORDER**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition to Remove Temporary Suspension filed by Respondent, Aubrey Lewis Davis, on May 13, 2008; upon the Hearing Panel Judgment and Recommendation filed on June 3, 2008; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court grants Respondent's petition and adopts the judgement and recommendation of the Hearing Panel.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED by the Court that:

- (1) Respondent's temporary suspension is hereby dissolved and Respondent is permitted to resume the practice of law based upon his agreement to contact Tennessee Lawyer Assistance Program ("TLAP") Executive Director Laura Gatrell and to comply with TLAP's requirements.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$775.00, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary. Payment of the costs assessed by the Board is a condition precedent to Respondent's resumption of the practice of law.
