ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on September 30, 2024, by the Petitioner, Wendell Cornelius Dawson. Mr. Dawson was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on January 26, 2024, for a period of three (3) years with three (3) months' active suspension. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating the petition is satisfactory to the Board Mr. Dawson has satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline, and he is eligible for reinstatement.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

- 1. The Petitioner, Wendell Cornelius Dawson, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c).
- 2. Mr. Dawson's reinstatement to the active practice of law and grant of probation is conditioned upon his continuing compliance with, and timely satisfaction of, the conditions set forth in the Order of Enforcement entered January 26, 2024. In the event Mr. Dawson fails to satisfy any of the conditions of probation as set forth in the Order of Enforcement, the probation may be revoked pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §14.2.
- 3. Mr. Dawson shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution may issue if necessary.

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
