

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against Respondent, Charles David Deas by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") on February 9, 2007; upon an Answer to Petition for Discipline filed by Respondent on March 19, 2007; upon a Conditional Plea of Guilty submitted by Respondent on August 13, 2007 pursuant to Rule 9, § 16.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court; upon the approval and recommendation of disciplinary counsel and the Board; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the Hearing Panel's recommendations and adopts and incorporates by reference the recommendations as the Court's Order.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

- 1. Respondent shall receive a public censure and shall make restitution to Bobby and Jeffrey Paschal in the amount of \$3,500.00.
 - 2. Respondent shall notify the Board in writing when restitution has been made.
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$2,036.00, plus any additional costs assessed by the Clerk of this Court, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary; and
- 4. The Board shall cause notice of this public censure to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
