PUBLIC CENSURE




The above complaint was filed against John H. Dickey, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on December 10, 2010.

On July 2, 2010, Respondent wrecked his automobile and was subsequently charged with 2nd Offense DUI, Violation of the Implied Consent Law, and Violation of Due Care. Respondent admitted to the arresting officer that he drank a large quantity of alcohol prior to the accident. Respondent's criminal charges triggered the filing of a petition against Respondent for Violation of Probation for his previous convictions of three counts of reckless endangerment and resisting arrest, also relating to substance abuse. On October 1, 2010, Respondent pled guilty to 2nd Offense DUI and Violation of Probation.

By the aforementioned facts, John H. Dickey, has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 8.4(b) (misconduct) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
