PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Robert Allen Doll, III, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain facts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on March 14, 2014.

Mr. Doll failed to render competent representation, failed to act with reasonable diligence, and failed to expedite litigation. Also, Mr. Doll failed to attend hearings and failed to comply with court, for which he was ultimately held in contempt.

By the aforementioned acts, Robert Allen Doll violated the Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1 (competence), 1.3 (diligence), 3.2 (fairness to the opposing party and counsel), and 8.4 (conduct prejudicial to administration of justice) and is hereby Public Censured for these violations.
