**ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION**

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Jonathan William Doolan from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Declaration of J. E. “Buddy” Stockwell, III, Executive Director of the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program (“TLAP”).

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Declaration of J. E. “Buddy” Stockwell, III, the Court finds that Jonathan William Doolan, Respondent, is substantially non-compliant with a TLAP monitoring agreement and poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. Jonathan William Doolan is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
2. Jonathan William Doolan shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
3. Jonathan William Doolan may make an application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Jonathan William Doolan to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
