ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 22.2 and 22.3, upon a Notice of Submission filed by Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility consisting of a certified copy of the *Judgment* of conviction entered in *State of Tennessee v. Jeremy Ryan Durham*, Case No. 2023-D-2049, Criminal Court for Davidson County, Div. IV (attached as Exhibit A), demonstrating Jeremy Ryan Durham, a Tennessee attorney, was convicted of a serious crime, i.e., one (1) count of Felony Reckless Endangerment. In addition, Jeremy Ryan Durham was convicted of non-serious crimes, i.e., one (1) count of Driving Under the Influence, one (1) count of Driving Under the Influence Per Se, one (1) count of Resisting Arrest, and one (1) count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED
BY THE COURT THAT:

1. Jeremy Ryan Durham is suspended from the practice of law on this date pending further orders of this Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 22.3;
2. This matter shall be referred to the Board of Professional Responsibility for the institution of a formal proceeding in which the sole issue to be determined shall be the extent of the final discipline;
3. Jeremy Ryan Durham shall fully comply with the provisions of Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys; and
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.

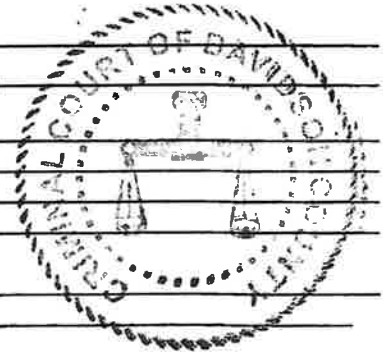

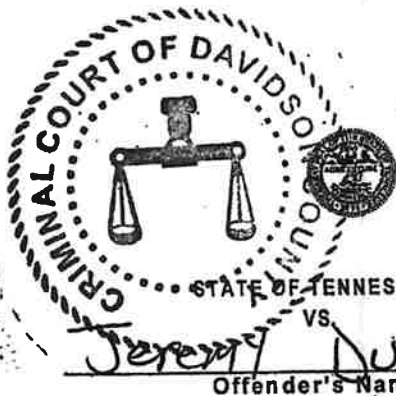

3. I will not receive, own, possess, ship or transport any firearms, ammunition or weapon.
4. I will work at a lawful occupation and support my dependents, if any, to the best of my ability.
5. I will request the permission of my Probation Parole Officer before changing my residence or employment. I will get the permission of my Probation Parole Officer before leaving my county of residence or the State. I will report immediately within 48 hours, after release from incarceration or sentencing hearing, to my Probation Parole Officer. I will report within 24 hours if my conviction requires my initial placement on the sex offender registry.
6. I will allow my Probation Parole Officer to visit my home, employment site, or elsewhere, will carry out all lawful instructions he or she gives, will report to my Probation Parole Officer as instructed; will comply with the Standards of Supervision, my Case Plan, and any programming referrals, will comply with a referral to Resource Center programs, if available, by attending, will comply with all imposed sanctions to address non-compliant behavior and will submit to electronic monitoring and community service, if required.
7. I agree to a search, without a warrant, of my person, vehicle, property, including any internet-capable devices, and place of residence by any Probation Parole Officer or law enforcement officer, at any time.
8. I will not use intoxicants (beer, whiskey, wine, etc.) of any kind to excess, or use or have in my possession illegal drugs. I will not enter an establishment whose prime purpose is to sell alcoholic beverages (bars, taverns, clubs, etc.). I will submit to observed drug screens as directed.
