PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against James Charles Edwards, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter at its meeting on September 9, 2016.

Mr. Edwards failed to diligently represent his client and failed to expedite the filing of his client's divorce action. After Mr. Edwards' representation was terminated by his client, Mr. Edwards submitted an unreasonable invoice for fees to the client. The fees were unreasonable based upon the lack of complexity of the legal services requested and the lack of any results obtained for the client.

By these acts, James Charles Edwards has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3 (diligence). 1.5 (fees), and 3.2 (expediting litigation) and he is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
