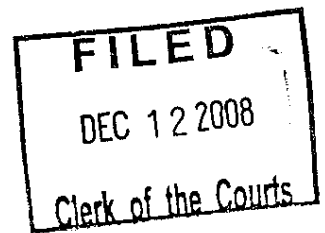

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Final Discipline filed by Disciplinary Counsel against Respondent, Glenn Erikson, on February 20, 2008; upon the Judgment of the Hearing Panel filed on October 8, 2008; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts the Judgment of the Hearing Panel and adopts the Judgment of the Hearing Panel as the Court's Order.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court:

1. That Respondent is hereby disbarred pursuant to Rule 9, § 4.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
2. That the Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Rule 9, § 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court regarding the obligations and responsibilities of disbarred attorneys.
3. That pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$363.00, plus the costs assessed by the Clerk of this Court in this cause, for all of which execution shall issue if necessary.
4. That the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
