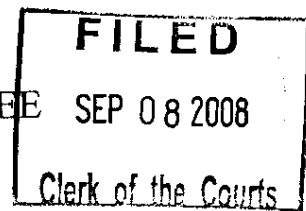

ORDER


This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Transfer to Disability Inactive Status filed by Respondent, James R. Everett, III, on May 9, 2008; upon the Response of the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") filed on May 27, 2008; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which it appears that Respondent should be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period and until further order of this Court.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 21.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent is hereby transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period and until further order of this Court.
2. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 25.2 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, this Order shall become a public record upon filing; however, all other documents relating to Respondent's disability proceeding, including any subsequent petition for reinstatement, shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
3. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay the Board's expenses and costs in the sum of \$593.00, plus the costs of the Clerk of this Court, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
4. The Board shall cause notice of this transfer to disability inactive status to be published pursuant to Rule 9, §§ 18.10 and 21.4 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
