ORDER DISSOLVING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

On January 22, 2026, this Court entered an Order granting the Board’s petition to suspend Dalen L.P. Farmer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, section 12.3 for failing to respond to the Board concerning a complaint of misconduct. On February 12, 2026, Mr. Farmer filed a Petition for Dissolution demonstrating he had responded to the disciplinary complaint and complied with all conditions imposed by the Order of Temporary Suspension.

On February 19, 2026, the Board filed an Answer admitting that Mr. Farmer has now submitted a response to the disciplinary complaint, which Disciplinary Counsel deemed sufficient. The Board further states that the basis for the temporary suspension has abated and that a hearing on Mr. Farmer’s petition is unnecessary.

Based upon the foregoing facts and circumstances, the Court is satisfied that a hearing under Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3(d) is unnecessary and that Mr. Farmer is entitled to immediate dissolution of the January 22, 2026 temporary suspension.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. The temporary suspension imposed upon Dalen L.P. Farmer by Order of Temporary Suspension entered January 22, 2026, is hereby dissolved.
2. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
