- 3. That respondent, Stuart W. Fields, may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Rule 9.

The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published in compliance with Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Sections 18.5 and 18.6.
