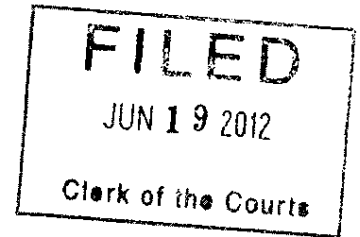

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Richard Bryan Fields from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of A. Russell Willis, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Richard Bryan Fields has failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning five complaints of misconduct.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that:

1. Richard Bryan Fields is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3.
2. Richard Bryan Fields shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
3. Richard Bryan Fields may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Richard Bryan Fields to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9.
