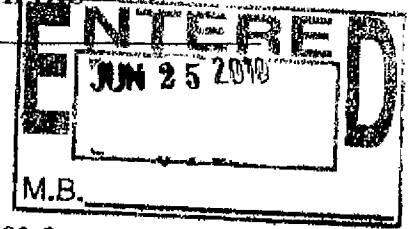





CONSENT ORDER ON MOTION FOR VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL OF  
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO SET ASIDE JUDGMENT


