SHELBY COUNTY LAWYER PLACED ON DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

By Order of the Tennessee Supreme Court entered August 16, 2016, the law license of Timothy Darnell Flowers was transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time pursuant to Section 27.3 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9.

On August 1, 2013, Mr. Flowers' license to practice law was suspended by the Supreme Court of Tennessee for three years after a hearing panel determined Mr. Flowers had violated Rules of Professional Conduct. The Order transferring Mr. Flowers to disability inactive status does not affect his disciplinary suspension.

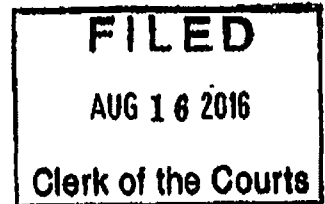
Pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 28.1, the Order transferring Mr. Flowers to disability inactive status is effective upon entry. Mr. Flowers may petition for removal of disability inactive status pursuant to Tenn. Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 27.7.

**ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO
DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS**

This matter is before the Court upon a petition to transfer Timothy Darnell Flowers to disability inactive status filed by the Tennessee Board of Professional Responsibility pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.3.

Upon due consideration of documentation from Mr. Flowers' medical care provider submitted by Mr. Flowers, the Court concludes that Timothy Darnell Flowers is currently incapacitated from continuing the practice of law.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. The law license of Timothy Darnell Flowers shall be transferred to disability inactive status for an indefinite period of time and until further orders of the Supreme Court.
2. Mr. Flowers shall be allowed to petition for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.7.
3. The Board shall publish notice of this transfer pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §§ 27.5 and 28.11.
4. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 32.4, documents other than this Order relating to Mr. Flowers' disability proceeding shall not be public records and shall be kept confidential.
