PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Robert Dean Flynn, #007941, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June 12, 2026.

Over the course of six months, Mr. Flynn knowingly comingled personal and client funds in his firm's IOLTA and paid personal and operating expenses from the account. Mr. Flynn held a client's funds for 49 days, during which time the IOLTA fell below the client's held balance of \$3273.70 for a week before the account became overdrawn, placing the client's funds at risk. No clients suffered actual harm from Mr. Flynn's actions.

By these acts, Mr. Flynn has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.15(a), (b), and (c) (safekeeping property and funds) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
