## ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Garry Christopher Forsythe from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of Kevin D. Balkwill, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Garry Christopher Forsythe, Respondent, has misappropriated funds to the attorney's own use and poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

## It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that:

- 1. Garry Christopher Forsythe is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 2. Garry Christopher Forsythe comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- 3. Garry Christopher Forsythe may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Garry Christopher Forsythe to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
