CHATTANOOGA LAWYER PLACED ON DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

By Order of the Tennessee Supreme Court entered February 25, 2008, the law license of George Lane Foster of Chattanooga was transferred to disability inactive status pursuant to Section 21 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The transfer to disability inactive status arises out of the Board of Professional Responsibility filing a Petition with the Supreme Court requesting transfer to disability inactive status. Mr. Foster cannot practice law while on disability inactive status. Mr. Foster can return to the practice of law only after reinstatement by Order of the Supreme Court upon showing by clear and convincing evidence that his disability has been removed and that he is fit to resume the practice of law.
