ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

The Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, filed a Petition for Discipline on January 20, 2004. On February 23, 2004, the Board of Professional Responsibility filed a Motion for Default Judgment. On June 16, 2004, the Hearing Panel entered an Order Granting Default Judgment.

On August 9, 2004, the Hearing Panel convened. Disciplinary Counsel was present. Respondent, who had been sent notice of the hearing, failed to appear.

The Hearing Panel after hearing argument of Disciplinary Counsel and after reviewing the record, recommended that Respondent receive a six (6) month suspension to run consecutive with Respondent's February 6, 2004 disbarment. A copy of the Hearing Panel's Findings and Recommendations is attached as Exhibit A.

It is therefore **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that the Hearing Panel's decision is approved and entered for enforcement by the Court.

It is further **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that Christopher Robin Fox shall pay the costs of these proceedings in the amount of \$_582.00, for all of which execution shall issue if necessary. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published pursuant to Section 18 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9.
