
The Board of Professional Responsibility properly designated a Hearing Panel consisting of James A. Crumlin, Jr., Chairman; Paul A. Alexis and Anne C. Martin. On August 9, 2004, this Hearing Panel convened with Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility present. The Respondent was sent notice of the hearing but failed to appear.


The Board filed a Petition for Discipline against the Respondent on January 20, 2004. The Respondent did not file an Answer. On February 23, 2004, the Board filed a Motion for Default Judgment and that the Charges Be Deemed Admitted. On June 16, 2004, this Panel entered an Order Granting Motion for Default Judgment.


**RECOMMENDATION**

THEREFORE, the Panel, after hearing argument of Disciplinary Counsel and after reviewing the record, recommends the Respondent receive a six (6) month suspension, to run consecutive to the Respondent's disbarment entered by the Supreme Court on February 6, 2004.
